Exporting: The Export add-on allows a DWF, DXF, R13 or CAD format drawing to be saved in the desired format from within AutoCAD. Exporting a DWG file is possible in the drawing panel. This is a very useful

feature for printed drawings, and allowing the image to be saved as a file that can be opened in any other program. Export can also export DXF files to other programs. The Export add-on also includes the ability to export several DWG files to one PDF, JPEG, TIFF, or SVG file. This feature allows a user to combine several DWG drawings into one PDF, JPEG, TIFF, or SVG file. The finished file is presented as one image in the PDF, JPEG, TIFF, or SVG format. Sharing: The Sharing tab of the Options dialog allows the author to configure and set specific sharing options for the current drawing. In addition to the user-configurable options, a number of the sharing options, such as the default settings for sharing, the default share folder and file name, and the default settings for printing are stored in the drawing. The current settings for

sharing and storing are then propagated to all open drawings and to all drawings in the current session. The settings that are maintained during the lifetime of a drawing are called persistent sharing settings.

Security: The Security tab in the Options dialog allows the Author to define security rules for any drawing that has access to the local network or Internet. A network security rule allows the Author to allow or deny external access to a drawing. A drawing can also have security applied to it that is separate from the security of the entire drawing project. A drawing can have multiple security rules. The security rules are determined based on the security of the current session and the security of the entire drawing project. The security of a drawing is determined based on the privileges and security levels of the user

that is currently logged on. In addition, all settings from any drawing can be shared with the current drawing and stored in the current drawing for the lifetime of the drawing. The security settings can be changed in the security settings of any drawing (any of the drawings or the current drawing). A user can change the permissions (access to drawings, folder, etc.) for any other drawing by right-clicking the drawing and selecting "Security". Export button and Options panel In earlier releases of AutoCAD, exporting a drawing only allowed exporting individual elements and layers. You could also export entire sheets and drawings. However, in previous releases of AutoCAD, the export dialog box was too small for a practical and convenient export method. It

was missing the option to export to Excel or CSV formats. The Export button also didn't fit the new smaller dialog. Now when you press the button, you get a box with a variety of new options to export to different formats, including drawings in any format. With the Options panel, you can now make the most of that new space. The panel includes tools for generating a printout, a list of active graphics on the screen, and the option to open a specific file
